## **M-Step Testing**

In June 2014, the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) started to develop a new test, the new assessment system will be called the Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress, or M-STEP. This has replaced the MEAP tests our students traditionally completed in the fall.

The M-STEP will be our schools summative assessments designed to measure student growth. English language arts and mathematics will be assessed in grades 3–5, science and social studies in grade 5. This test will be taken on-line, utilizing our Chromebooks and computer lab. Our 5th grade students will begin



testing on April 12th, our 3rd and 4th grade on May 3rd. The testing windows are three weeks long. Students will not be testing everyday, and tests in each area will take about one hour. Please make sure your child attends regularly during testing windows. We will run make-up sessions for students who are absent. We are excited to show the great progress we have made in the past year. Please encourage your child to give their best effort!

## Kindergarten Registration 2021-2022

Houghton Portage Township Schools has begun registering kindergarten-aged children for the 2021-2022 school year. Children who will be five years of age by December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021, are eligible to enter kindergarten or Young 5's. Please call Houghton Elementary School at 482-0456 ext. 3040 to register. Children currently attending Young 5's are automatically registered for kindergarten.
